We had many different types of services for our family - one to one sessions, Early Learners Group, Prep for School Group, Siblings Group all at Rosehill.

Having a Keyworker was great - having one person to talk to, for planning and co-ordinating therapies and organising Individual Family Service Plans (IFSP). You could bounce ideas around to try and find the best solutions for issues. **A keyworker that could liaise with preschool/school etc was extremely helpful. It took a lot of stress out of the situation.**

Zach is in Year 5 at Tallowood School (SSP) at Kellyville. He loves playing soccer, horse riding, cooking and he still loves trying new things and gives everything a go with a smile on his face! Two of his most favourite things are soccer and Motiv8 Sports. Soccer is an All Abilities/Football4All program and Motiv8 Sports is a mainstream holiday program he goes to with his support worker each holidays.
